## **Federal Compliance Section Updates**

- High Priority HSW Recertification
  - High Priority with the possibility of beneficiaries not being eligible and could be disenrolled/made ineligible if not received on time with all the required information needed. Could also raise concerns from CMS if we have a significant decrease in compliance with these federal obligations in our annual 372
  - BHDDA is struggling to process re-certification due to a variety of missing information (i.e. dates, signatures, IPOS goals, etc.) Each time it is sent back it delays the process even further and jeopardizes eligibility, services, and payment.
- 1115/1915(i)-See attached fact sheet, webinar, and FAQ
  - Following CMS's guidance, Michigan will transition all of the specialty behavioral health services and supports currently covered under 1915(b)(3) authority to a 1115 Demonstration and 1915(i) HCBS state plan benefit effective October 1, 2019.
  - CMS has granted MDHHS/BHDDA time for process change through established milestones to complete all evaluations and reevaluations of beneficiaries enrolled in and/or seeking 1915(i) HCBS state plan service benefits by October 1, 2022.
  - At that time MDHHS/BHDDA will determine 1915(i)SPA eligibility and the PIHP provider network will be responsible for perform face-to-face assessments, compile required documentation, and submit findings to the MDHHS/BHDDA. The MDHHS/BHDDA will make the determination of needs-based criteria through an independent evaluation and re-evaluation
  - BHDDA: Provided iSPA fact sheets, 9/18/19 informational webinar, related resources, and frequently asked questions for the field
- Update on 2020 Waiver Changes
  - Peer Supports/Peer Integrated Services moved to the State Plan. CMS approved
  - Supports Coordination Services moved to the State Plan under targeted case management. CMS pending
    - Adds Supports Coordinator, Supports Coordinator Assistants, Independent Services & Supports Brokers
- Code Forecast
  - Overnight Health and Safety = T2027/15 minute units
  - Non-Family Training = S5116/encounter covered under HSW, SEDW, CWP
- Medicaid Provider Manual Changes
  - Initial policy promulgation will be done on the 1915(i) State plan benefit and the renewals of the 1915(c)'s added service of Overnight Health and Safety Supports (OHSS).
- In December of 2018 MDHHS put out a document to forecast clarifications to Supported Employment and Housing Assistance. What if any tweaks or additional clarifications to these services will be implemented in response to the newly approved waiver?
  - Supported Integrated Employment: Minor language and reorganization, but the focus of competitive and integrated is the same.
  - o Overnight Health and Safety Services: Additional language added per the OHSS stakeholder workgroup

  - No changes for Housing Assistance Services

**Background:** Michigan asked CMS to consolidate its 1915 (b/b3)/(c) waivers into one 1115 for integrated behavioral and mental health specialty services. CMS is guiding Michigan to continue the pursuit of the 1115, keep all three of the 1915 (c) waivers, amend the current state plan, and add an additional 1915 (i) SPA for the rest of the 1915(b)(3) services.
